Information to prepare for a field trip

- The **PBS Kansas Cochener-Garvey Children's Education and Discovery Center** is located inside PBS Kansas Channel 8 at **8710 E. 32nd Street N. Wichita, KS, 67226**
- Our field trips are typically scheduled from 10 a.m.-noon. You will arrive at 10 a.m. We will work together to clean up at 11:45 a.m. for your noon departure.
- The Center can accommodate about 50 students at one time. If your group is larger than 50, we could discuss possible options.
- The Center is geared toward children 10 years old and younger.
- All of our activities are located in one large room.
- We have the following stations throughout the room:
 - Engineering Station, Makerspace, Weather Station, Video Creation Station (green screen), Food Science Station, Reading & Media Station and The Little Tigers' Den.
- We have a gently used bookshelf. Each child is welcome to take home a free book from the bookshelf each time they visit.
- Bathrooms are located outside of our main room. Students who need to use the restroom will need to be accompanied by an adult.
